





INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Turn power OFF from the electrical panel before installation.
- 2. Use the included template to cut a hole in the ceiling. (Fig. 1)




See below size of the cutout template:
3" models: 3" diameter


3. Open the drive box and remove the needed knockout(s). (Fig. 2)



4. Insert the electrical supply cable through the knockout and secure with a cable connector. Wire driver box (*Fig.3*), white - white, black - black, green - green/ground.



5. Place all wiring and connections back into the driver box and close the cover and select the color temperature (CCT). (Fig. 4)



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS (cont'd)

6. Place the driver box into the ceiling and connect the fixture to the driver box. (Fig. 5)









7. Lift both retention tabs upward and push until the trim sits flush against the ceiling surface. (Fig. 6)






8. Installation complete (Fig.7)


