

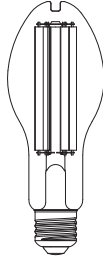

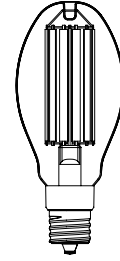

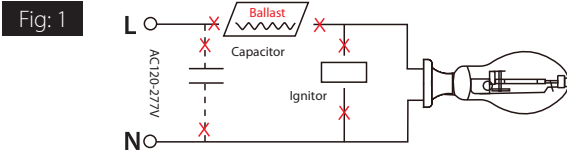

WARNING: Make certain power is OFF before installing or maintaining fixture. No user serviceable parts inside.

CAUTION: This device is not intended for use with emergency exits. Risk of electric shock. Do not use if outer lamp envelope is damaged or broken.

LAMP INSTALLATION

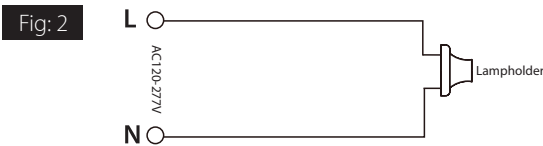
1. Remove old ballast or disconnect from existing lampholder. Remove and dispose of ballast in correct manner. Shown as Fig. 1. (North America 120-277VAC)



3. Install new LED replacement lamp. Shown as Fig. 3. Be sure that the old fitting is correctly grounded. Attach retrofit label to luminaire. (North America 120-277VAC)



2. Reconnect directly to the existing lampholder. Shown as Fig. 2. (North America 120-277VAC)
