

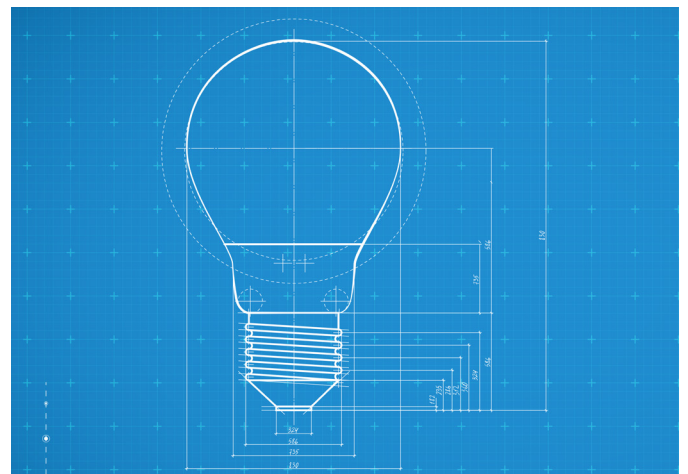


California Title 20 & 24 Compliance. One system, code-ready lighting control.



Title 20 vs Title 24.

Title 20 regulates which lighting products can be sold in California. Title 24, Part 6 regulates how lighting systems must operate once installed to meet energy code.



Why Title 24 compliance matters.

Title 24 compliance directly impacts project approval, inspection success, and timelines. A compliant lighting control system reduces risk, prevents delays, and simplifies specification and installation.

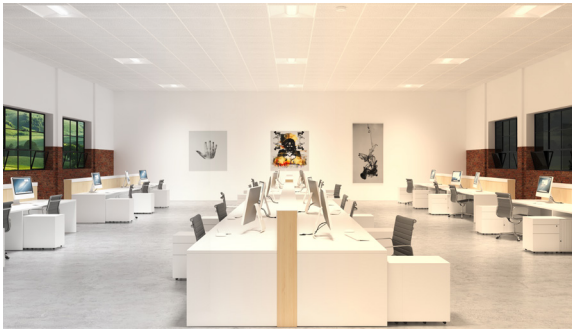

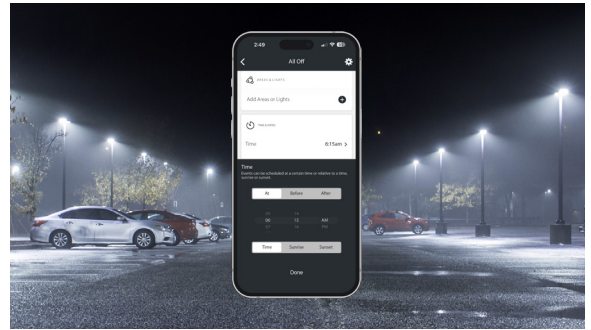
Automatic shutoff and manual controls.

Lightcloud supports the required automatic shutoff by using scheduling, dimmers, and keypads while maintaining the manual control functionality required for daily operation and code compliance.



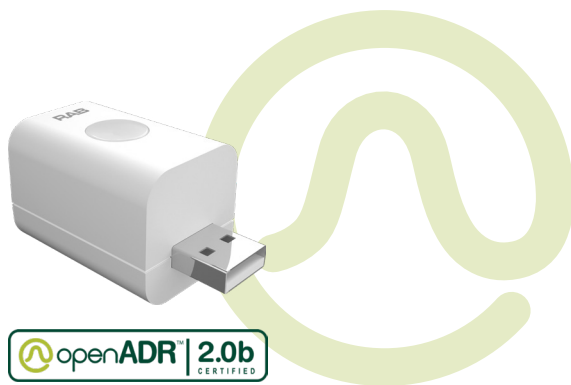
Occupancy sensing and daylight harvesting.

Lightcloud uses occupancy sensors and daylight harvesting to automatically adjust light levels based on space use and available daylight, reducing energy use without compromising comfort or safety.



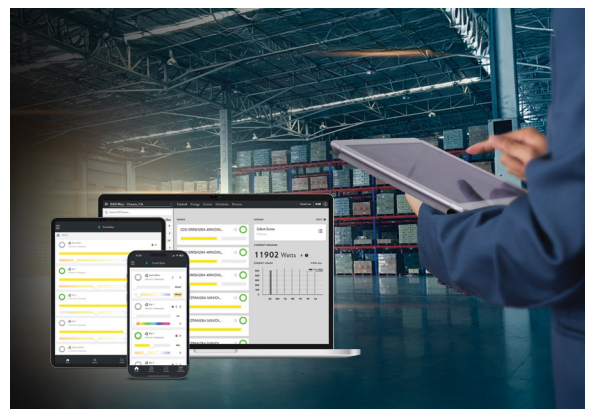
Outdoor lighting control strategies.

Lightcloud controls outdoor lighting with photocells and schedules to reduce output during low-activity periods and ensure exterior fixtures operate only when needed.



Demand response.

Lightcloud supports demand response through a simple Nano setup, so designing for code compliance is easy—no gateway required!
