INSTALLATION

1. Before installing the bulb, shut off power supply at the circuit breaker panel to avoid electrical shock. It is recommended that surge / lightning protection be installed. Ballast must be bypassed if present.
2. Remove old bulb.
3. Screw new bulb in clockwise. Do not overtighten. Overtightening may cause damage to the light.
4. Individually pivot each of the adjustable panels down to best cover the desired space. Depending on the type of light fixture, it may be necessary to pivot light heads out of the way before screwing the bulb into the fixture.
5. Restore power.

- 6. Turn on light switch. Bulb will illuminate immediately.
- 7. Adjust all angles as needed. (Do not stare directly into LED lights when adjusting settings.)

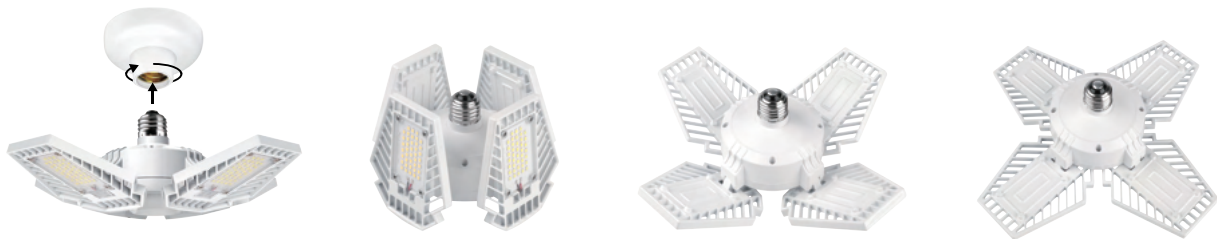

WIRING

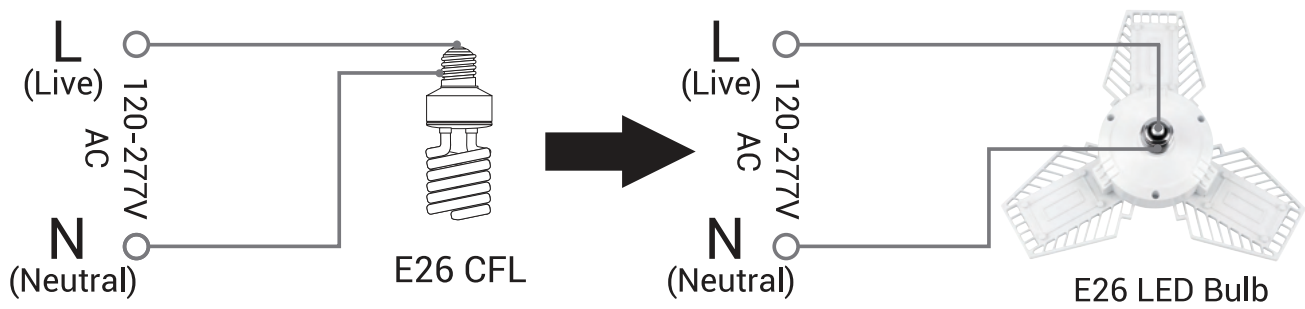

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

CAUTION: Be sure fixture temperature is cool enough to touch.
Do not clean or maintain while fixture is energized.

- 1. Turn power OFF.
 - 2. Use a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive glass cleaner.
 - 3. Lightly wipe and clean the fixture.
- DO NOT use solvents.
DO NOT use cleaners containing abrasive ingredients.
NEVER spray cleaning liquid directly onto the LEDs, fixture, or wiring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Probable Cause	Solution
Fixture does not turn on.	Bad connection.	Check wiring connections.
	Faulty switch.	Test switch or replace it.
	Power is off.	Verify power supply is on.
Circuit breaker trips or fuse blows when light is turned on.	Discontinue use immediately.	Call an electrician.
